OLD BUSINESS

The minutes from the 3/19/22 board meeting were approved and will be posted to the website.

NEW BUSINESS

1. WEEKLY COMPETITION RULES

The weekly competition is 18 holes and you are eligible to participate in weekly competition if you play 18 holes, have a GHIN handicap, and have all competition scores attested by either a member of WSWG or WSGC (formerly known as the men's club).

Weekly competition consists of the following:

- Completion of either the purple or gold competition score card
- Recording ECCIES
- Recording Chip-Ins
- Recording Birdies

In order to record any of the above competition scores:

- All play must take place either on a Tuesday or Saturday. On those Saturdays when the course is not available for Saturday play, an alternative day of the week will be provided to the Saturday players (hopefully a Sunday).
- A player may only enter one competition score per week (this includes ECCIES, chip-ins and birdies) but may choose between Tuesday or Saturday scores.
- It is important to always turn in a competition score card. It is acceptable to put DQ on the score card and you will still be eligible to enter ECCIES, chip-in's and birdies for that day.

- To keep up the pace of play, once you have hit 10 shots simply put a 10X for that hole and move on to the next hole.
- Weekly competition winners/winnings will be posted on the locker room bulletin board and can be found in the Sign Up Genius for our club on line.
- Weekly competition winnings will be put into the pro shop account once a month under the players name and can be used at the Seattle Parks golf course pro shops: Interbay Golf Center, Jackson Park Golf Course, Jefferson Park Golf Course, or here at West Seattle Golf Course (but not for greens fees).

REMEMBER TO ALWAYS POST YOUR SCORES IN GHIN AS THIS IS ALSO A REQUIREMENT IN ORDER TO WIN THE WEEKLY COMPETITION
