



## 2023 WEEKLY COMPETITION, BIRDIE/CHIP-IN and ECCIE RULES

### Weekly Competition

Members of the WSWG are encouraged to participate in weekly competition, the more members who participate, the more payouts can be given. To enter Weekly Competition the following rules apply:

1. You must have a GHIN handicap and must post your score for that day.
2. You must finish 18 holes to be eligible for competition prize money.
3. Competition formats and divisions will vary and are set by the Weekly Competition Chair. In order for weekly compensation to be distributed, a minimum of 5 scorecards must be turned in from each tee (normally gold and purple). If scorecards are turned in from the green or white tees, the Weekly Competition Chair has the discretion to create a green/white division or include those scorecards into the purple division.
4. Weekly Competition Scorecards may only be submitted on designated WSWG league days (typically a Tuesday or a Saturday. Occasionally, the Head Pro may need to substitute a Sunday for a Saturday). If a player submits scorecards on both Tuesday and Saturday, the best score of the two days will be used.
5. **You must correctly complete the competition sheet and you must indicate the tees you played from and your corresponding handicap for those tees. Your competition score sheet should be deposited in the competition box (located in the locker room) on the same day of play.**
6. You must have your competition scorecard attested (date and signed) by a WSWG member who was partnered with you during the 18-hole round.
7. You must pick up and record a 10X on your competition sheet once you have reached 10 strokes on any hole. Anything lower than 10 strokes you must "PUTT OUT".
8. Weekly competition winners/winnings will be posted in the women's locker room.
9. Weekly competition winnings will be put into the pro shop account once a month under the player's name and can be used to purchase merchandise, cart rentals or special orders. This credit book money may also be used at all four city courses, but it is preferred you use it here to support the West Seattle pro-shop.

### Birdies/Chip-ins/Eccies:

1. Birdies, Chip-ins and Eccies may only be recorded on the designated WSWG league days, as noted above, regardless of submitting a weekly competition scorecard. They must be attested (date and signed) on the designated sheet located in the WSWG locker room by a WSWG member who was partnered with you during the 18-hole round.
2. Birdie and Chip-in sheets (posted on a bulletin board) and individual Eccie sheets (kept in a folder) shall be retained in the women's locker room.
